



Code of Conduct & Child Welfare

Please ensure you and your family, including your child read and adhere to the rules set out in the Respect Code of Conduct, for both the players and spectators.

Mepal & Sutton FC expects its members to behave in a respectful manner at all times. Any child found to be not following the Code of Conduct during training will be issued with a warning in the way of a yellow card. If the behaviour continues, they will be issued with a red card. A red card will result in a phone call being made to the child's parent/carer asking them to immediately collect their child from training and then being dropped for the next scheduled training session and/or match. This rule is one we are hoping not to have to use but is there to ensure that training is fun and beneficial to everyone.

Mepal & Sutton FC are committed to promoting inclusion and to manage and eliminate discrimination of any form and encourage equal opportunities. Mepal & Sutton FC will not tolerate harassment, including sexual harassment, bullying, abuse or victimisation of a participant, which for the purpose of this policy and the actions and sanction applicable is regarded as discrimination, whether physical or verbal.
